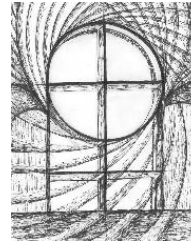

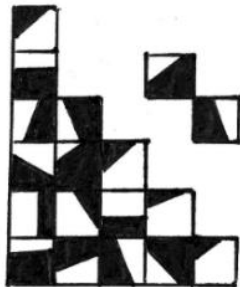
## Vision Statement
