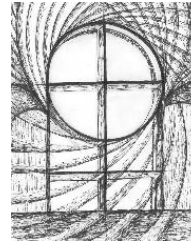

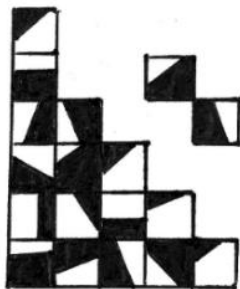
Vision Statement
