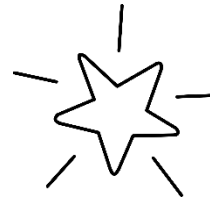
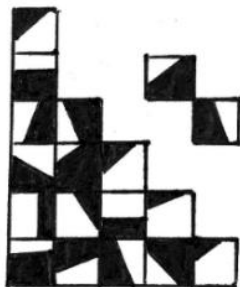
Vision Statement
