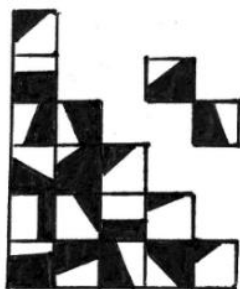
## Vision Statement
