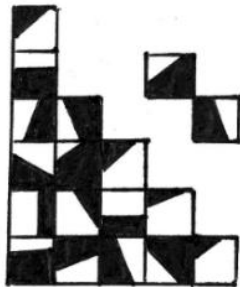
Vision Statement
