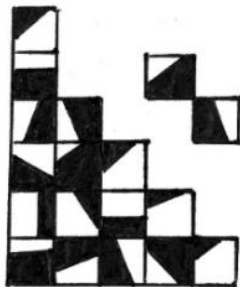
Vision Statement
