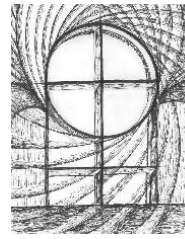
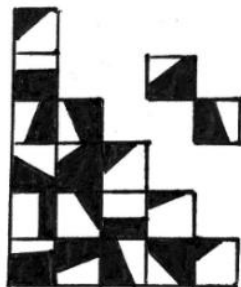
Vision Statement
