

Vision Statement



ENNEAGRAM: TOOL FOR CONVERSION AND GROWTH

This 10-week series focuses on the Enneagram as a tool for conversion and growth. With its theory of nine basic types of people, the Enneagram helps us understand both our gifts and limitations and illuminates a path for transformation and growth. It can be an important tool for healing and improving relationships with family, friends, and work colleagues. It can also guide us to new paths for experiencing God's presence and power in our lives.
