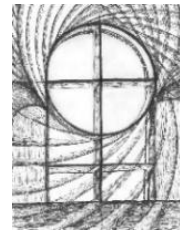
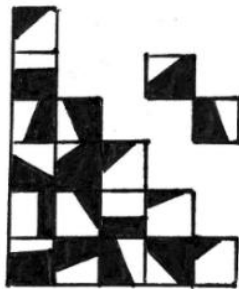
Vision Statement
