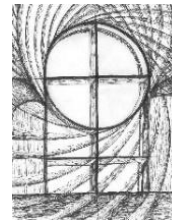
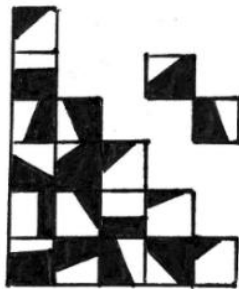
Vision Statement
