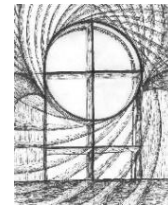

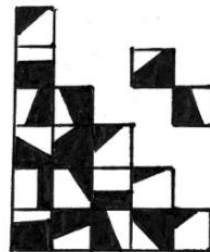
Vision Statement
