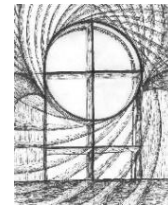

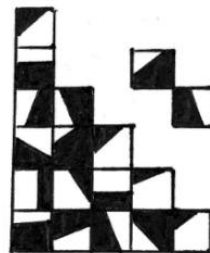
Vision Statement
