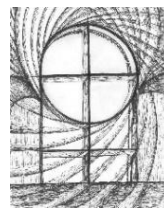
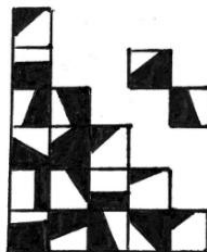
Vision Statement
